BUDAPEST

Tue 1st July

11:50am Arrival Budapest Airport on AF1694, meet your coach and our Prague Concert Co. tour escort and check into **Hotel ASTORIA(★★★★)**

07:00pm Dinner at the hotel

Wed 2nd July

Breakfast at the hotel

10:00am Guided sightseeing tour, during which you will see such famous sights as the Fishermen's Bastion, St Matthias Church and Heroes Square (without entrances)

Lunch independent

Afternoon at leisure

07:00pm Dinner in the Restaurant Marvany Menyasszony
This is a typical Hungarian restaurant, located in the Buda side of the city, 15 minutes drive from the hotel.
The restaurant provides gypsy music during the evening.

Thu 3rd July

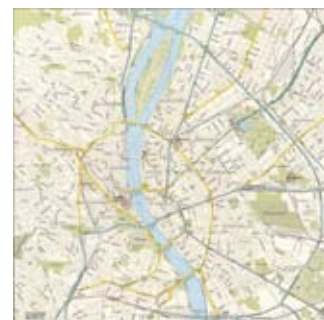
Breakfast at the hotel

03:30pm Arrival in Gumpoldskirchen – pick up from a town's representative – short walk to the church and the rectory, where the group may deposit their belongings – Short historical overview of the city of Gumpoldskirchen

04:15pm Sound check and short rehearsal at the church (about 20min)

05:15pm Reception at the City Hall of Gumpoldskirchen (They will offer wine, grape juice and bread) – ceremonial installation of the memorial plate (name and origin of the choir will be mentioned on this plate!) at the city hall.

06:15pm Short city walk through Gumpoldskirchen



06:45pm Arrival at the church – rehearsal
 07:30pm **Concert in the church (duration: 1 hour)**
 08:45pm Dinner in a nice restaurant in Gumpoldskirchen – As it is located within the heurigen area, the group will have there the opportunity to taste the excellent Austrian wine.

 Guided s/s tour of Prague on foot (starting at Prague Castle district) with licensed city guide without entrances
 Lunch independent
 Afternoon at leisure in Prague
 07:00pm Buffet supper cruise on the River Vltava on a private chartered boat (duration: 2 hours) with the opportunity to view the illuminated historic buildings of Prague by night
